

Interactive Session on “Diversity in Law Field”, 9th September, 2020



Department of Law, MAIMS on 9th September, 2020 held an Interactive Session on “Diversity in Legal Field”. The session aimed to provide exposure to students about the diversity the legal field embraces. The esteemed resource persons for the session were, Mr. Rahul Aggarwal, Delhi, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Lakshadweep, Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu Civil Service (DANICS) and a law graduate and Mr. Mukesh Bhardwaj, Advocate, Supreme Court & Mentor, LAWIT.

Mr. Rahul Aggarwal began the session by laying his emphasizes on “Competitive exams & the strategy to prepare for the same”. He further enlightened the students of the ‘life changing capability’ of some crucial and popular competitive exams, viz, Judiciary or Civil Service exams. He continued further by sharing some pre requisites one should carry before and while preparing for the competitive exams. **Mr. Mukesh Bhardwaj** initiated his address of the second session by clearly pointing out the options available after attaining an LL.B decree. He stated three options available to the students, viz, Government Job, Private Job and Private Practice, commonly referred to as litigation or advocacy. Sir emphasized upon litigation as a career option. He put forward with experience that a good advocate or a litigator primarily needs ‘convincing capability’.
