

REPORT ON MAIMS 2ND NATIONAL MOOT COURT COMPETITION, 2021 & CELEBRATION OF CONSTITUTION DAY

26th November, 2021 to 28th November, 2021



The Department of Law, Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies, Delhi had organized the 2nd Edition of the National Moot Court Competition & Constitution Day Celebration, on 26th - 28th November, 2021 in hybrid mode. The Moot Proposition of MAIMS 2nd National Moot Court Competition, 2021 was released on 18th September, 2021 along with the official Brochure and detailed rule book on the website of the institute, social media platform of MAIMS Moot Court society as well as on the website of their official media partner.

The inaugural ceremony of the event was conducted physically, following all the COVID-19 precautions on 26th November, 2021, to recognize the event of Constitution Day. The event was graced by the presence of Chief Guest Hon'ble Mr. Justice Jayant Nath, (Retd.), Former Judge, Delhi High Court. A total of 46 teams from lengths and breadths of the country, participated in the competition with enthusiasm and research. The day started with a Researcher's Test that took place early in the morning. A total of 56 judges adjudged the proceedings in court rooms in good faith. The final round took place between Sinhgad Law College, Pune and Symbiosis International University, Pune The team of finalists argued with enunciation and clear expression for each perspective.

The Valedictory Ceremony of MAIMS, 2nd National Moot Court Competition 2021 was conducted virtually on 28 November 2021. The event was graced by the presence of Chief Guest Hon'ble Justice C. Harishankar, Judge, Delhi High Court. The Chief Guest, Hon'ble Justice C. Harishankar, began his address by appreciating the theme of the moot proposition and jovially remarked that he was thankful that he was spared the herculean task of judging the moot competition. He said challenging moot problems, such as those given to contestants; prepare law students to handle cases with ease as they enter the legal profession. He also advised the students to be prepared for the cases, to be courteous and honest and continue to read textbooks.

Thereafter, Prof. (Dr.) Rajni Malhotra Dhingra, Principal, Dept. of Law announced the results of the competition.
