INTRODUCTION

A Mock Trial is a simulation or enactment of a judicial proceeding. Mock trials provide students with knowledge of the judicial system, legal process, and courtroom procedures.

Mock trials helps to: Develop students' questioning skills, critical thinking, and oratory skills; demonstrate the roles of various actors in the legal system and provide them with exposure to legal resource people, such as judges, academicians and lawyers or advocates. Mock trials may be based on historical events, cases of contemporary interest, or hypothetical situations and fact patterns.



OBJECTIVES

- To facilitate practical learning & knowledge building for law students.
- To help law students adapt to different forms of work environment.
- To motivate law students all across India and encourage the holistic development of their interpersonal and professional skills.



APPROACH

The event shall be organized in a hybrid manner wherein the Preliminary Rounds I and II, and the Quarter-Final Round shall be conducted in the Online Mode through ZOOM Platform. The Researcher's Test shall also be organised in the Online Mode and shall be conducted via submissions made towards a priorly shared Google Form, comprising of both subjective and objective questions.

The last two rounds i.e., Semi-Finals and Finals shall be organized in the Offline Mode in the MAIMS Campus. The teams for the Semi-Finals shall be given a sufficient time period of 2 weeks to make the arrangements for their arrival at the venue.



COMPETITION GUIDELINES

CHAPTER - I: GENERAL RULES FOR THE COMPETITION

A. DATE & VENUE

- The 'MAIMS 1st National Mock Trial Competition, 2022' will be held from 1st September 2022 to 17th September 2022. This event shall be conducted in Hybrid Mode for which the below-mentioned segregation shall be followed:
 - Online Rounds:
 - Preliminary Rounds I & II; and
 - Quarter-Final Round.
 - · Offline Rounds:
 - Semi-Final Round; and
 - Final Round.
- NOTE: Accommodation shall be provided to the teams qualifying for the Offline Rounds. [Subject to COVID Protocols]

B. TEAM ELIGIBILITY & COMPOSITION

- The competition is open for students who are pursuing LL.B threeyear/five-year course during the current academic year.
- Only one team is permitted to participate from each participating Institution/University.
- Each team shall consist of three members. However, with the prior permission of the organisers, a two-member team shall also be eligible to participate.
- A team shall require minimum of two Speakers as a mandatory prerequisite.
 A three and/or two member team shall include one separate or either Speaker, as the Researcher respectively.
- Each team would be provided with three Witnesses, 45 minutes prior to the Rounds.

C. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE



- All the participating teams must confirm their participation by filling out the below-attached Registration Form.
- For Registration: Click Here.
- As per the rules, each team shall be allotted a Unique Team Code for the competition upon completing the Registration. Each team must use the Team Code for any further communication with the organizers during the course of the competition.
- The identity of the teams shall not be disclosed at any stage, such disclosure shall result in penalties including disqualification. The decision for the same shall be at the discretion of the Organizers.
- Any change in the team composition must be intimated to the organizers at the earliest through an Email at mocktrial@maims.ac.in.
 Such change must be accompanied by filling a new Registration Form.
- Participants will receive a confirmation email, signifying the acceptance
 of their request for participation latest by or before 3rd July 2022.
- The participating teams are required to pay Rs. 4500/- [Rupees Four Thousand Five Hundred only] as Registration Fees.
- However, an Early Bird Discount is being offered and the teams availing the offer will be paying Rs. 4000/- [Rupees Four Thousand Only] on or before 10th June 2022 [23:59 IST].
- The Last Date for Payment of Registration Fee is 30th June 2022 [23:59 IST]; [Refer Chapter - V].

CHAPTER - II: STRUCTURE OF THE COMPETITION

A. PRELIMINARY ROUNDS I & II

- The Preliminary Rounds shall be held on 2nd September 2022.
- It shall be conducted in the Online Mode.
- All the teams shall compete twice in the Preliminary Rounds [Preliminary Rounds I & II].
- After completion of the respective rounds, the best eight teams shall qualify to the Quarter-Final Round.

B. QUARTER - FINAL ROUND

- The Quarter-Final Round shall be held on 3rd September 2022.
- It shall be conducted in the Online Mode.
- After completion of the respective round, the top four teams shall qualify to the Semi-Final Round.

C. SEMI - FINAL ROUND

- The Semi-Final Round shall be held on 17th September 2022.
- It shall be conducted in the Offline Mode.
- After completion of the respective round, top two teams shall qualify to the Final Round.

D. FINAL ROUND

- The qualified teams shall compete in the Final Round which shall be held on 17th September 2022.
- This round shall be conducted in the Offline Mode.
- After completion of the respective round, the team with the highest score shall win the competition.



E. RESEARCHER'S TEST

- The Researcher's Test shall be held in Online Mode on 2nd September 2022 via submissions made towards a priorly shared Google Form.
- It shall comprise of both subjective and objective questions.
- The test shall be of maximum 100 marks.
- Qualifying marks shall be 50.
- Participants scoring less than 50 marks shall not qualify.
- The organizers shall have the discretionary right to not award the "Best Researcher" title to any team, if none of the teams score the minimum marks.
- The syllabus of the Researcher's Test shall be as follows:
 - The Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973;
 - The Constitution of India, 1950;
 - The Indian Evidence Act. 1872:
 - The Indian Penal Code 1860:
 - Any other relevant laws/statutes related to the Mock Proposition.

MAIMS 1st NATIONAL MOCK TRIAL COMPETITION, 2022


The Ceremony followed by the draw of lots and then exchange of memorial.

On 2nd September, 2022, the second day of the National Mock Trial Competition, 2022, started with great zest and zeal. From 9:00 to 10:00 A.M. IST, a researcher's test was conducted for

all the participant researchers simultaneously allotment of witnesses to all the teams was done. The preliminary round I and II of the competition was conducted online through the zoom platform. A total of thirty-four teams from the different prestigious law schools from all over



India which went up against each other. At the end of this day, the preliminary rounds' results were announced and a total of eight teams qualified further for the Quarter-Final round.



On 3rd September, 2022 at sharp 9:00 IST, witness allotment was conducted and at 10:00 IST quarter-final round commenced on the zoom platform. After this, the results for the quarters-final round was declared and four teams i.e TC 100, TC 30, TC 40 and TC 15

qualified for the semi-final round.

On 17th September, 2022, the Semi-Final round and the final round was conducted offline at

the campus of MAIMS. The Competition Day started with the witness allotment for the semi-final round. Two courtrooms were allotted for the semi-final round, the Courtroom 1 was presided upon by the bench consisting of Mr. Vikram Seth, Advocate, Delhi High Court and Dr. Upma Gautam, Professor, University School of Law and Legal Studies for adjudicating and the Courtroom 2, was presided upon by the bench consisting of Mr. Nishant Anant, Advocate, Delhi High Court and Mr. Aditya Singla,

He also made comments on the importance of research for making effective legislation and ended up by wishing all the best to the participants.



The Founder Chairman sir, Dr. Nand Kishor Garg, he emphasises on the justice system in the society and makes use of the famous quote, "justice delayed is justice denied". He encouraged the students to work hard. The talented students of MAIMS, department of law by performed an act on child abuse naming "katra katra sach", which

ended up by making everyone emotional. Further, the Mock Trial Committee extended gratitude towards the judges for adjudicating the rounds and students coordinators for working hard for organising 1st National MAIMS Mock Trial competition, 2022. The results were

announced by Ms Tanvi Ghera, faculty of Department of law, MAIMS. Campus law centre, faculty of law, Delhi University i.e. TC 30 was adjudged as the winner with the cash price of Rs. 40,000 with certificate of appreciation and trophy. Christ (deemed to be university, Bangalore i.e. TC 15 was declared as the Runner up, with a cash prize of Rs. 25,000 with certificate of appreciation and trophy. MAIMS also provided awards in other categories for the cash prize of Rs. 5000 with certificate of appreciation and trophy. Wherein, Best Speaker, Zaid Akram Khan from KIIT, Bhubaneswar i.e TC 20.
