




## 2. Career orientation of syllabus


## 3. Interest generated by the syllabus


## 4. Sequence of units of the syllabus


## 5. Size of the syllabus in terms of class hours




7. How do you rate the outcomes that your student has achieved from the courses?




8. How do you rate the system of the evaluation system in the institute?






9. How do you rate the college activities that help your students in getting jobs and placements?








## 2. Curriculum in terms of developing critical thinking





## 5. Curriculum in terms of subject knowledge imparted






## 7. Curriculum in terms of professional attitude taught



In order to ensure growth, Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies under the supervision of IQAC has consistently promoted the importance of constant quality improvement. stakeholders, including students, teachers, employers, and graduates, and puts their suggestions into practise. All the stakeholders' responses are examined and generated trend is analysed through statistical analysis.

#### 1. PROGRAMME FEEDBACK BY STUDENT ANALYSIS

While reviewing the student feedback for the academic year 2021-22, the following observations were made:

- 2. Majority students have a positive outlook towards the curriculum content and its usefulness.
- 3. Majority students find the subjects interesting and gain knowledge.
- 4. Sequence of units and size of the subjects also received positive feedback from students.
- 5. Still, not all the students find a positive orientation towards syllabus and resources. The concerns can be further worked upon by discussing among the latter stakeholder.

#### 2. PROGRAMME FEEDBACK BY ALUMNI ANALYSIS

While analysing the alumni opinion for the academic year 2021-22, the following observations were made:

- 1. Majority alumni find the curriculum and learning values provided during the graduation period, relevant according to the industry standards.
- 2. Many are connected with the institute, still a lot of alumni are yet to connect on a continuous basis.

#### 3. PROGRAMME FEEDBACK BY TEACHERS' ANALYSIS

Following an examination of the teacher evaluations for the academic year 2021-22, the



following observations were made:

- 1. Faculties find the infrastructure and ambience of the institute friendly in terms of Teaching and using Teaching Aids.
- 2. Alignment of relevance of course and skills learnt at the institute and help in Job Placements also received positive feedback. This area needs more improvement as per changing market conditions.
- 2. Evaluation system and ease in syllabus revision was also observed as positive by the faculties.
- **3.** Faculties find that majority students undergo excellent transformation after the completion of the program.

#### 4. PROGRAMME FEEDBACK BY EMPLOYERS' ANALYSIS

While analysing the employer's opinion for the academic year 2021-22, the following observations were made:

- 1. Curriculum in terms of relevance and being up to date received a positive outlook from the Employers.
- 2. Curriculum reference regarding Hands on Skills, Professional attitude and Technical skills do require more improvement.
