About Department of Law

The Department of Law was established in 2017 by introducing a five-year integrated BALL.B degree course. Established as a unit of the Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies, the Department aims to provide quality education with a professional approach to the budding legal professionals. Entry to the five year course is through the rankings of the CLAT (Common Law Aptitude Test). There is a total intake of 120 students in BA LL.B. stream and 60 students in BBA LL.B stream every year. Higher education imparts in-depth knowledge and understanding so as to advance the students to new frontiers of knowledge. In order to open more avenues MAIMS, Department of Law introduced LLM (Master of Law) in Intellectual Property Rights from this year. The Department is equipped with requisite facilities like Moot Court, Legal Services Clinic, etc., as stipulated by the Bar Council of India. It has a mix of senior seasoned faculty as well as young and dynamic faculty.





The Value Added courses are designed to prepare a student for advanced education. They also help the students to connect previous courses with the current course he/she wants to join. Under the Value Added course basic knowledge of the upcoming course is imparted to the students so that they can understand basic of the upcoming course. Thus, Value Added course can be understood as supplementary knowledge that is imparted about advanced subjects which will be studied by students in the upcoming future.

Usually, it is found that the syllabus of each subject at graduation level is wider than the subject at Senior Secondary level. On the other hand, the student who did not study a subject at senior secondary schools faces many challenges while studying it. Thus, it becomes a necessity to conduct a Value Added Course before commencement of classes of first semester so that the students can overcome the future challenges.

Keeping the importance of Value Added Course in view, aValue Added Course is planned by Department of Law, Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies for newly admitted students of BALLB before the commencement of the classes of first semester. This is a maiden initiative by the department to Value Added the gap between subjects studied at senior secondary level and subjects they would be studying in BALLB.

BA LLB is an integrated program with duration of 5 Years. The syllabus of BALLB includes law subjects as well as non-law subjects. This Value Added Course is planned for History, Sociology, Economics, Political Science, and Legal English from October 11, 2021 to January 1, 2022. The resource persons for the course are Dr. Anuradha Asthana Singh, Dr. Nirdosh Kumar, Ms. Ritika Bhatia, Dr. V.K. Bhatnagar, Ms. Saumya Sharma respectively. Besides, a SCC Online session will be conducted on Saturday, October 16, 2021 in online mode. The resource person for SCC Online session is Mr. Chetan Singh Gill, a Master Trainer and Sr. Manager Training at SCC Online.



OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

- To supplement knowledge of the students.
- To prepare students for advanced course so that they do not confront any challenge when the classes commence.
- To develop curiosity among the students to know the newly opted subjects.
- To make classes interactive and productive since after getting basic knowledge of the subjects students can ask the question and participate in discussion.
- To impart basic knowledge of the subjects.



DURATION OF THE COURSE

The duration of the Course is 6 days(One Week) with 24 hours (20 hours for delivery of Course Curriculum, 2 hours for SCC online, 2 hours for Exam).



METHODOLOGY

The content of the course is designed separately for each subject keeping course curriculum in the focus. During the period (20 hours) above mentioned subjects will be taught and made the students understand about nuances of each subject. Apart from this, an online session of Two hours will be conducted on using SCC Online services. After completion of the Value Added course, an online test of Two hours (50 MCQ Question) will be conducted to measure performance and level (Slow/Advanced) of the students.


