The write-ups were accepted as stories, poems, raps, or any other form. The last date to submit the write-upswas August 13, 2021. The top 16 write-ups proceeded to the final round.

The second round commenced on Google Meet from 3 pm onwards. The top 16 participants were required to perform their write-ups and give a voice to their re-written story, inwhatever form it may be. The time limit for each performer stood at 5 minutes. The participants were free to use their imagination and creativity in presenting their entry in front of an online audience.

Participation in the event was simple. The participant has to pay the registration fee, which was Rs. 50 only, followed by filling a google form. The form recorded 31 enthusiastic responses.
