WAR OF WORDS-DEBATE COMPETITION (APRIL 17-24, 2021)

Debate is one of the academic activities that give students creative room to express what they feel. Augmenting the learning cycle of the students of the institute, War of Words-Debate Competition of Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies was organized for the first year students of BBA on April 17-24, 2021 in online mode. The competition aims to provide a platform for the students of undergraduate program of business administration and commerce to enhance their communication skills, to help them improve their business skills as well as to build up their confidence level. The whole event was held under the supervision of Prof. (Dr.) Vijay Kumar Khurana (Head, Dept. of Business Administration & IQAC Coordinator), Mr. Nakul Anand (Convenor) and Dr. Ekta Dargan (Co-Convenor).
