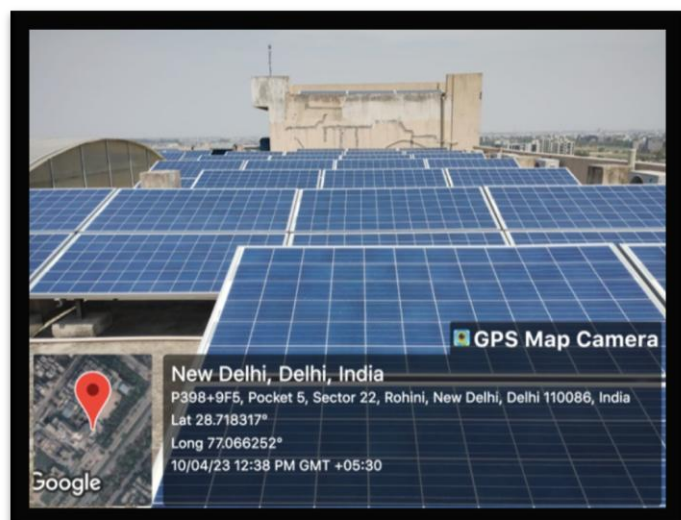


Photo-1: Solar Panel on the Roof of the Building of the Institute

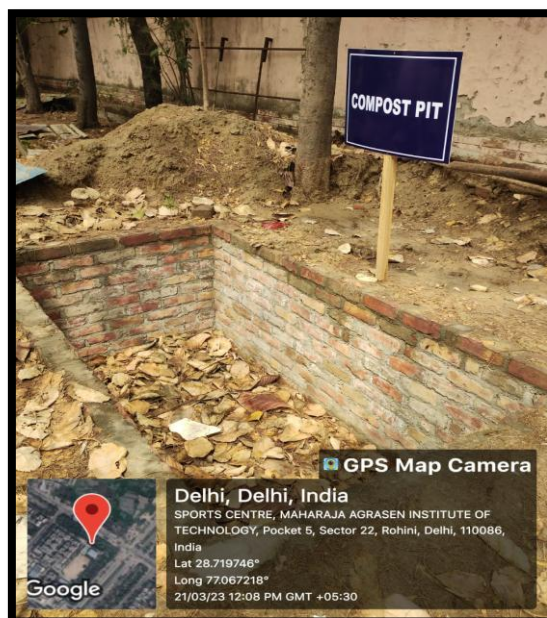

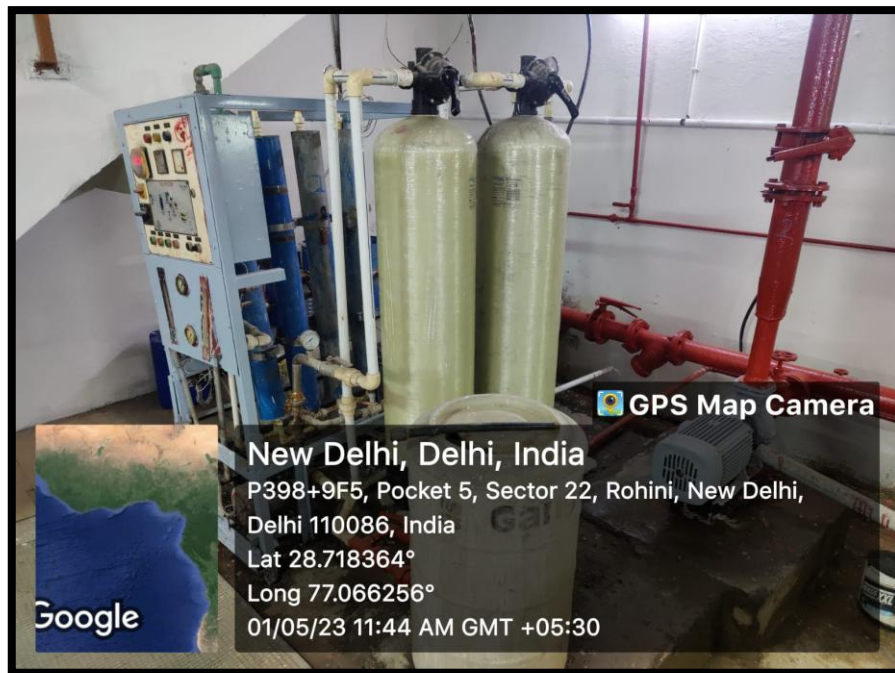

Water Conservation

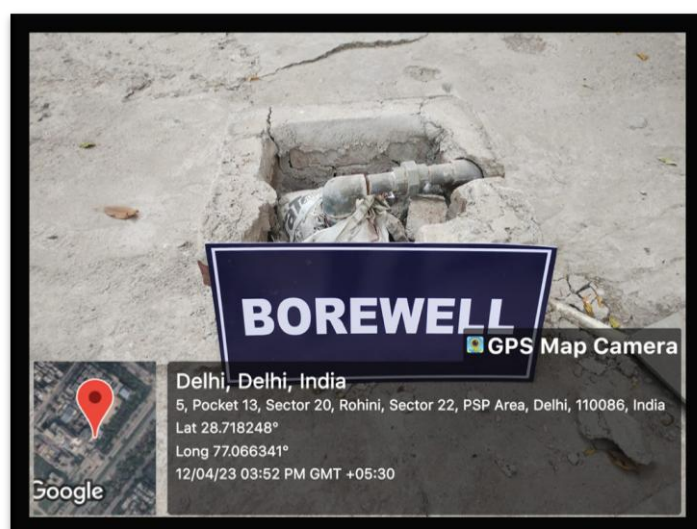

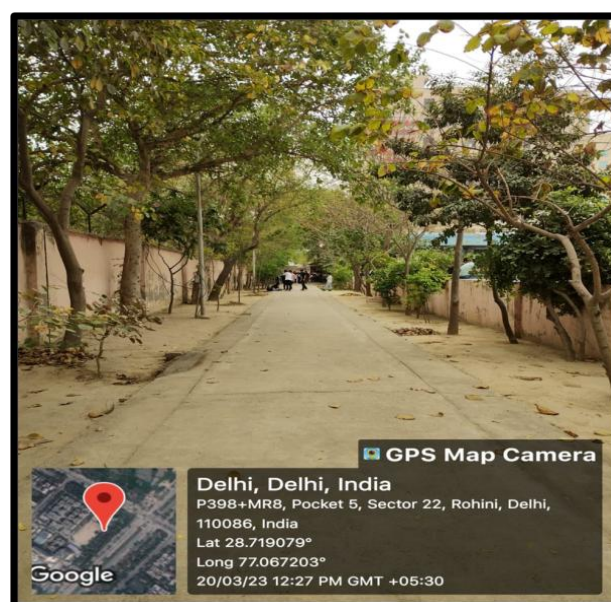

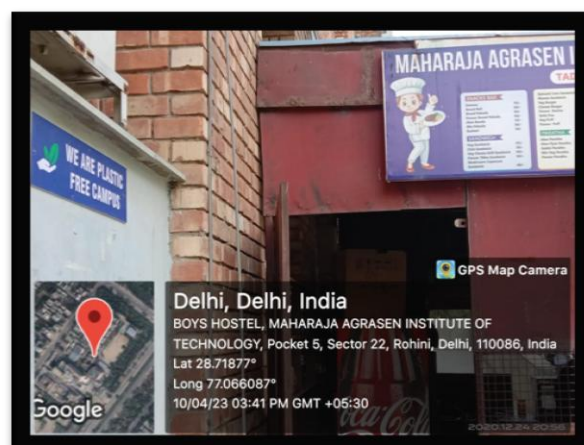

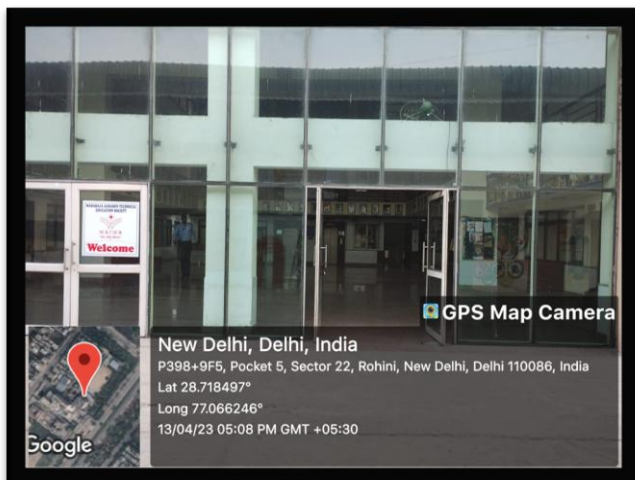
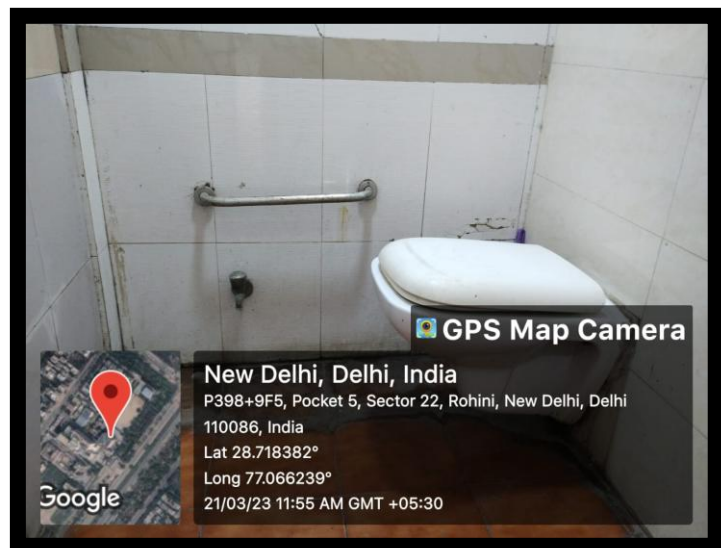
Disabled-friendly, Barrier Free Environment

Wheel chair and Computer with Braille Keyboard

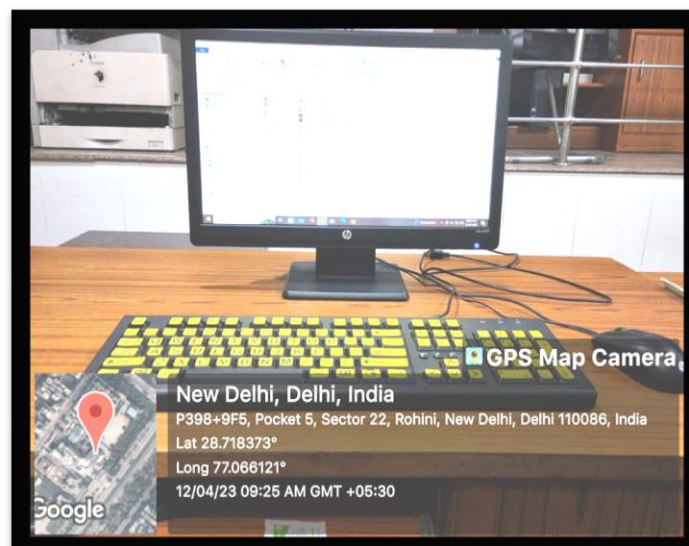
