

FDP on Data Analysis for Research using SEM & Panel Data

June 11-18, 2018

Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies organized One week Faculty Development Program on Data Analysis using SEM & Panel data from 11th – 18th June 2018. The FDP was inaugurated by Dr. Nand Kishore Garg, Founder Chairman, MATES along with Prof. M.K. Bhat, Director, MAIMS and Prof. Sangeeta Malik, Dean, MAIMS. There were 62 participants who attended the FDP. First session was taken by Dr. Sachin Gupta on the basics of research followed by hypothesis testing and regression analysis. He also explained and helped participants in understanding the applicability of various techniques. The sessions from 12th – 14th June 2018 were delivered by Dr. Neeraj Kaushik. He focused on scale building. exploratory factor analysis, Confirmatory factor analysis along with structured equation modelling. These enormous learning sessions ended with understanding of Moderation & Mediation effect. The last two davs $15^{th} - 16^{th}$ June 2018 were taken by Dr. Ajay Chauhan. He focused on more advances data analysis technique i.e., panel data. The eminent resource person tried to make participantsfamiliar with the basic meaning of panel data, its applicability and how the data must be organized for application of panel techniques. Many models have been discussed i.e., within & between effect, random& fixed effect model as well as dynamic models. This FDP saw the participation from various universities & colleges across India to name a few IIM Lucknow, IIT, Jamia, IGNOU, Delhi university, Amity university, Banaras Hindu university and others. All the participants appreciated the efforts of the organizers as well as shown their interest in the more future workshops. The FDP is concluded with certificate distribution to the participants.

" FIRST AID TRAINING AND SAFETY MEASURES"

for Non-Teaching Staff

December 12, 2017

Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies organized a one-day workshop on "First Aid Training and safety measures" for its non-teaching staff members keeping in mind the medical safety of the employees. The workshop was conducted on December 12, 2017, in the institute campus. The main focus of the training was to educate the staff members about the need of first aid, small medical procedures to be followed in emergency situation, how to tackle the emergency situation such as wounds, cuts and various other minor accidents. This workshop provided help to the staff members with the ability during emergency situations. If someone ingests dangerous substances or suffers health-related problem like heart attack, or if a natural disaster occurs, a person trained in the first aid becomes an invaluable support for the victim.

The training was provided by Dr. K. L. Sethi. The main agenda of this workshop was to train staff members and to impart them with the knowledge of first aid promotes a sense of safety and well-being amongst people. Having an awareness and desire to be accident-free keeps you safer and reduces the number of causalities and accidents. The workshop sessions focused on the basics of first aid, and how to provide first aid in wounds, bleeding, burns, heatstroke, poisoning, bites, drowning, fainting, seizures and unconsciousness. All staff members had hands-on experience of dressing the wound, applying different types of bandages, splinting the injured body part, providing cardiopulmonary resuscitation, and transferring the victim.


