to the audience. Dr. Gupta emphasized on maintaining the dignity of the educational institutions to keep at the level of Nalanda and to make India again "VishwaGuru". Sir introduced Shri Lakshmi Narayan Bhala Ji as a devoted and eminent spokesperson, an artist, a trustee for National Journalism Welfare Trust, Samarth Trust and Ramayana Research Council. He further expressed his delight to have our chief guest here and how he has played a significant role in reinterpreting the history of the Constitution. Dr. Gupta briefly mentioned the life history of Shri Lakshmi Narayan Bhala ji and his contributions to the society. He further emphasized on Bhala ji's role in writing commendable books which will be considered a boon to our youth and to our country.

The esteemed guest speaker presented a picturesque presentation on भारत का संविधान एक प्रदर्शनी: and talked about the significance of The Indian Constitution, its design and decorative aspects. He talked about the importance of spiritualism and further added that the Indian Constitution is the lengthiest Constitution of the world.

He further recited the shlok "संघे शक्ति कलौ युगे" meaning "Strength in Union in Kaliyuga" emphasizing on the spiritual aspects of the Constitution. He gave extreme significance to the spiritual gurus like Agrasen Ji and Mahavir Ji for making eminent contributions to the society.

The speaker also praised the renowned personalities like Dr. B.R Ambedkar, Nand Lal Bose and Prem Bihari ji and how they have played such a crucial role in the making of the constitution as Dr B.R Ambedkar being the chairman of the drafting committee, Nandalal Bose who took up the historic task of beautifying/decorating the original manuscript of the Constitution of India and Prem Bihari ji who wrote the constitution in italic calligraphy.

The graphic representation of pictures before the commencement of each Part was directly related to the subject matter present in that part whether it be the 'Vikramaditya's Darbar' or the 'Journey from Siddhartha to Gautam Buddha'.

Another interesting knowledge which he shared was about the 'Khandit Nataraja' and reversed 'Swastika' being there on the Part dealing with the Financial matters.

He later interacted with the students over Arjun and Eklavya of the Mahabharata, where he explained what kind of personalities these two were and then proceeded to ask who they will choose between Arjun and Eklavya. Most of the students wanted to be as brave as Eklavya and wanted to do things according to their will. Bhala ji also mentioned renowned Constitutional expert, Dr Subhash Kashyap and emphasized on the fact that no study of constitution complete without him.
