# **Report Industry Visit- Escorts Kubota Ltd.**

#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE INDUSTRIAL VISIT:**

- To provide practical exposure to the students.
- To make students understand about the working of manufacturing process.
- To provide knowledge about the latest trends and updates in manufacturing process.

On Thursday, 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2023, Department of Commerce, Maharaja Institute of Management Studies, organized an industry visit to Escorts Kubota Ltd. Escorts Kubota Limited formerly Escorts Limited is an Indian multinational conglomerate that operates in the sectors of agricultural machinery, construction machinery, material handling, and railway equipment. Its headquarters are located in Faridabad, Haryana. The company was launched in 1944 and has marketing operations in more than 40 countries. Escorts manufactures tractors, automotive components, railway equipment, and construction and material handling equipment.

The objective of the visit was to help students gain a practical insight behind industry's working methods and operations. The visit was organized to provide students with an opportunity to test their theoretical knowledge and understand the practical functioning of industry system. 44 students from the Commerce Department, MAIMS along with Dr. Kamal Gupta, Assistant Professor (Department of Commerce) and Ms. Shreya Garg, Assistant Professor (Department of Commerce) went for the visit.

The day started with a motivating address by Prof. (DR.) Rajni Malhotra, Director, MAIMS and Prof. (Dr.) Manju Gupta, Head, Department of Commerce. Prof. (Dr.). They started with pointing out the importance of industry visit in building entrepreneurial mindset among students and enhancing their understanding.

Following the address note, students were boarded in the bus and the bus left the college at 7:30 A.M. The bus reached the industry unit at 10:15 A.M and students were gathered at the main operation ground of the unit. The Plant Manager of the corporation welcomed students and started explaining the background of the Agricultural machinery industry, manufacturing plant, processes and working methods followed in the corporation. They also highlighted the operation techniques adopted by the manufacturing plant for the optimum utilization of resources.

The Plant Manager gave a full tour of the plant explaining the complete manufacturing of Tractor from starting to ending. The students were taken to different sub-units for better understanding of manufacturing process. The students participated enthusiastically and cleared their doubts regarding the different aspects of the industry like finance, marketing and operations etc.

The visit ended at 2 P.M and students were boarded back into the bus and were dropped to the college.
