They also highlighted the significance of each machine present in the operation ground. Students took an active interest and came up with lot of questions which were attended by the Manger.

The Chief Head and the Manager of the corporation gave a full tour of the industry unit explaining the logistics and importance of each segment. The students were taken to all the sub units like storage, segregation point, loading and unloading docs. The students participated enthusiastically and cleared their doubts regarding taxing of commodities, competitors existing in the industry, technicalities of the operations etc.

The visit ended at 3:00 P.M and students were boarded back into the bus and were dropped to the college.
