A Resin Art Workshop was organized by SRIJANA- the Fine Arts society of MAIMS in the academic session 2023-24. The workshop was hosted by a resin art artist, Ms. MEGHA GARG. The workshop was conducted on 15th of May,2024 in offline mode in Room no. 937 in MAIMS Campus.

The workshop was designed with the following objectives in mind:

- 1. Introduce students to the fundamentals of resin art, including materials, techniques, and safety precautions.
- 2. Provide hands-on experience in creating resin artworks, allowing students to experiment with colors, textures, and designs.
- 3. Foster artistic expression, creativity, and innovation among participants.
- 4. Encourage collaboration, communication, and peer learning within a supportive environment.
- 5. Inspire students to explore new forms of artistic expression and pursue their passion for the arts.

The workshop comprised a series of engaging activities tailored to the needs and interests of participants:

- 2. Safety Briefing: Guidance on handling resin safely, including ventilation, protective equipment, and proper disposal procedures.
- 3. Demonstration Sessions: Live demonstrations of resin pouring techniques, color mixing, layering, and creating various effects.
- 4. Students were provided with materials and tools to create their own resin artworks under the guidance of experienced instructors.

When all the artworks were left to dry up. At 3.00pm, Dr. Sumedha Dutta and Dr.. Shallu Aggarwal visited the workshop, appreciated our host and provided a sampling as a token of love. They also appreciated the participants artworks. The workshop concluded at 4.00pm on same day.
