


Q1. How do you rate the structure of program offered in terms of the courses in different semesters?


Q7 How do you rate the outcomes that your student has achieved from the courses?

The Department of Economics has always believed in continuous quality enhancement. With The same goal at hand, the Institute takes regular feedback from all the stakeholders, namely, students, teacher, employer and alumni to implement their recommendations. The feedback taken on the curriculum was analysed for all the stakeholders.

1. PROGRAMME FEEDBACK BY STUDENT ANALYSIS, 2023-24

The following points were noticed while analysing the student's feedback for the academic year 2023-24:

- Students are quite satisfied with the content and standard of syllabus with reference to the program.
- Majority of the students are content with Career Orientation of Syllabus.
- 3) Students find the syllabus to be interesting and well disbursed in terms of class hours.
- Students find the teachings given in the course as skill oriented and optimum learning resources are available in the library.

2. PROGRAMME FEEDBACK BY ALUMNI ANALYSIS, 2023-24

The following points were noticed while analysing the alumni feedback for the academic year 2023-24:

- The alumni were quite happy and satisfied with the level of curriculum provided to them. They
 found it relevant and updated.
- Almost 81 per cent of the alumni found the facilities provided by the department were upto the mark.
- Around 90 per cent of the alumni have acquired learning values in terms of concepts, knowledge, skills analytic abilities, broadening perspective applicability to real life situations.

3. PROGRAMME FEEDBACK BY TEACHERS' ANALYSIS, 2023-24

The following points were noticed while analysing the teachers' feedback for the academic year 2023-24:

- 1) Around 80 per cent of the teachers have agreed that structure of the program and infrastructural and teaching aids available in the department are appropriate.
- 2) 90 per cent of the teachers find autonomy and ease in syllabus revision process.
- 3) Around 90% of the teachers believe that the course structure being updated with latest skill structure help students in getting jobs and placements.

4. PROGRAMME FEEDBACK BY EMPLOYERS' ANALYSIS, 2023-24

The following points were noticed while analysing the employers' feedback for the academic year 2023 24:

- 1) All the employers are of belief that the curriculum is indeed relevant, up to date and is capable of developing the critical thinking. Students can correlate between practical corporate world and teachings given in the course.
- Employers agree that students are having appropriate technical skills, subject knowledge and professional attitude.
