On 29th September 2024, students from the Legal Services Clinic, MAIMS, took part in a Nukkad Natak Competition organised by the Kirdaar Dramatic Society of Baba Saheb Ambedkar Medical College under Amnesia 2024. Our team, named PINAAK, comprised of 11 members, performed a play on social issues like domestic violence, drug abuse, and gender inequality. The competition started at 10:30 AM with a rally to get the teams energized. A total of 8 teams participated; each addressed different social issues through their performances. PINAAK's plays focused on raising awareness about domestic violence, drug usage, and gender disparity. The time limit for each play was 20 minutes. Three experienced panelists judged the event. Each team presented its unique take on important topics, and the performances highlighted both their acting talent and the strength of their messages. The competition ended at 3:00 PM, and Moksh, the Dramatic Society of Sri Aurobindo College, DU, were declared the winners. They received a cash prize of ₹10,000 and a trophy. All teams were given participation certificates. The Nukkad Natak Competition was a valuable experience for the students of the Legal Services Clinic. Their team, PINAAK, used street theatre to raise awareness about key social issues. The event

also helped them to learn various things, like teamwork and advocacy skills, aligning with the mission of the Legal Services Clinic to promote social responsibility through various forms of engagement.
