Proposed Courses of Action for Improvement in Programme Outcomes

Based on the overall attainment scores provided, all Programme Outcomes (POs) and Programme-Specific Outcomes (PSOs) have met or subsceed the target of 2.1 (70%) on a scale of 3. Hence, to foster continuous improvement, following proactive measures are planned:

PO1: Inculcate critical thinking to carry out research objectively without being biased with preconceived notions & equip the student with skills to analyze problems. Action Plan:

- 1. Conduct workshops on research methodologies and bias mitigation techniques.
- 2. Introduce case-study-based learning to enhance problem analysis skills.
- 3. Integrate interdisciplinary research opportunities to develop a broader critical perspective.
- 4. Organize peer-review exercises for student research to promote unbiased evaluation.

PO2: Formulate a hypothesis, evaluate and validate results, and draw reasonable conclusions thereof; prepare students for pursuing legal research in varied fields. Action Plan:

- 1. Provide training in hypothesis formulation and experimental design through seminars.
- 2. Implement guided research projects where students develop and validate hypotheses.
- 3. Develop a mentorship program with industry professionals or academics for hands-on guidance in research.
- 4. Establish a feedback mechanism for hypothesis testing and result validation.
