Agendas of the meeting are:

1. Approval of Minutes and Action Taken Report (ATR) from Previous Meeting:

- a. The minutes and ATR of the IQAC meeting held in August 2023 were presented.
- b. Members reviewed and appraised the ATR and expressed satisfaction with the progress and actions taken.

2. Filing for Autonomous Status:

- a. Members were informed that, on the suggestion of Shri S. P. Aggarwal, Executive Chairman, MATES, MAIMS is initiating the process of applying for Autonomous Status.
- b. The benefits of obtaining autonomous status, including academic flexibility and enhanced reputation, were discussed.
- 3. Application for New Program (BCA) and Additional Intake in B. Com (H):
 - a. It was decided to apply for the introduction of the BCA program with an intake of 60 seats.



- b. Additionally, approval for 60 seats in the second shift of B. Com (H) was sought.
- c. Members were informed that BBA and BCA programmes will now fall under the governance of AICTE.
- 4. International Conference on "Re-Imagining Business with Focus on Sustainable Development":
 - a. The Institute is planning to organize an international conference in February 2024.
 - b. Departments concerned were tasked with coordinating the event and raising adequate sponsorship to cover the conference expenses.
- 5. Review of the Odd Semester (AY 2023–24) and Action Plan for Improvement:
 - a. The teaching of the odd semester has concluded, and heads of departments (HoDs) were asked to review its progress.
 - b. HoDs highlighted that delayed admissions by GGSIPU, finalized in late September 2023, reduced the time available for first-year students to complete the syllabus and prepare for end-term exams.
 - c. To address this, extra classes were arranged to ensure syllabus completion and adequate preparation for students.

6. Tenure Completion of Current IQAC Coordinator:

- a. The tenure of the current IQAC Coordinator was set to conclude on 31st December 2023.
- b. The Coordinator informed the committee about the same.
- c. All members unanimously decided to extend the tenure for another two years in recognition of her valuable contributions.
