OBJECTIVES OF THE SESSION:

- To raise awareness among college students and potential voters about the significance of voting in a democratic country.

- To provide a platform for discussions on democratic rights and duties.

The Department of Commerce organized the event "Lokmat Parishkar: Vote for a Better Tomorrow" to raise awareness among college students, particularly new & fresh voters, about the importance of voting in democratic India.
