Nomination and Application (Google Form)

- 1. A **Google Form** was created to invite nominations for the Alumni Selection Committee.
- 2. The form included fields for:
 - Personal details (Name, Batch, Contact Information)
 - Alumni Engagement Experience (Past involvement with college events)
- o Statement of Interest (Why they want to join the committee)
- 3. The form was shared via:



- 4. The submission deadline was set, and reminder messages were sent to encourage participation.



B. Voting and Selection (Online Polling)

- 1. After the nomination period, eligible candidates were shortlisted based on their engagement and suitability.
- 2. A **polling system** (via WhatsApp polling system) was set up.
- 3. Each registered alumnus received a **unique voting link** to prevent multiple votes.
- 4. The voting window was kept open for a specified period, and real-time vote tracking was enabled.
- 5. The **top-voted candidates** were selected to form the Alumni Selection Committee.
