SUBMISSION OF RESEARCH PAPERS

Review Policy

Maharaja Agrasen Journal of Law believes in the encouragement of critical analysis and the interdisciplinary study of law. Submissions which view the subject matter from a comparative perspective shall be preferred. Therefore, the scholastic quality of the manuscript shall be the primary criterion for publication. The same shall be judged by anonymous peer review of the manuscript. However, the final discretion as to the acceptance of the manuscript rests with the Editorial Board.

Publication Policy

Maharaja Agrasen Journal of Law publishes original material. Therefore, manuscript must neither be under consideration for publication in any other place at any time during the period of consideration by the Journal, nor previously published. The Maharaja Agrasen Journal of Law also has a strict policy on plagiarism. The Plagiarism more than 20 % shall render the manuscript liable for rejection.

Submission of Contributors

Contributions for the Maharaja Agrasen Journal of Law are solicited for articles, book reviews, essays, case comments and legislative comments. Contributions should adhere to the following specifications:

1. **WORD LIMIT & STYLE:** The word limit for articles and essays is between 4.000 to 7.000 words. The manuscript must be in English and should be checked for grammar and syntax. The manuscript should be written in A4 size, "Times New Roman", Font Size-12 with 1.15 spacing with at least a one-inch margin on all sides.

2. **CITATION FORMAT:** The citation format to be used is THE BLUEBOOK: A UNIFORM METHOD OF CITATION (19th ed.). Speaking footnotes are generally discouraged.
3. **ABSTRACT:** Every submission must be accompanied by an abstract of not more than 150 words followed by 5 key words, which outlines the area of study and any important conclusion that may be drawn by the author(s).
4. **COVERING LETTER:** All personal details, including name, designation, name of college/university, postal address, phone number and e-mail id. must be provided in a separate letter or file, and must not be mentioned in the document or file containing the submission.
