### **Report**

The Legal Services Clinic (विधि मित्र) of Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies (MAIMS) organized a guest lecture on "Legal Aid" on 19th March 2025, in collaboration with Shri Ankur Panghal, the Secretary of North DLSA. The event also included a prize distribution ceremony for the तिरंगा Tales Competition.

The main purpose of the session was to explain the concept of legal aid and the rights and responsibilities of paralegal volunteers. Shri Ankur Panghal explained the difference between Article 226 and Article 32 of the Indian Constitution, highlighting that Article 226 allows High Courts to issue writs for enforcing both

fundamental and other legal rights, while Article 32 empowers the Supreme Court to issue writs specifically for enforcing fundamental rights.

He also engaged the audience by discussing the “Golden Triangle” of the Indian Constitution, which includes Articles 14, 15, and 19.

After the lecture, the winners of the तिरंगा Tales Competition were awarded for their creativity and hard work.

The event was attended by the Director, Prof. (Dr.) Rajni Malhotra Dhingra, the Head of the Law Department, Prof. (Dr.) Praveen Kumar Gupta, and faculty coordinators Dr. Purnima Gupta, Ms. Akanksha Tagra, Ms. Simran Chhabra, and Dr. Monika Jain, whose presence added value to the event.
