The event was held on 15<sup>th</sup> of October,2024 in offline mode in basement and ground floor in MAIMS Campus. The two competitions were PIXEL ART & CERAMIC PAINTING and BEYOND BOUNDARIES (art exhibition). Pixel art competition commenced at 11:00 am, the participants were given 2 hours to complete their artworks. The competition had a turnout of 95 students. The art exhibition commenced at 12:30 pm and the artworks were displayed till 4:00. The exhibition included artworks from our society along with 3 other societies from other colleges (MAIT, Hansraj College, Bharati College). A team of 5 members came from each college to exhibit their artworks. The Second competition CERAMIC PAINTING commenced at 1:30 pm.
