Session on The Expert's POV: Where experience speaks for itself

On 16 February 2026, Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies conducted an insightful session titled “ The Expert's POV: Where experience speaks for itself ” organized by the The Training and placement cell, Department of Commerce. The session was designed to broaden students' understanding of practical career pathways and critical skills in the modern business landscape.

The session conducted in the seminar hall, featured **Mr. Tarun Goel**, a distinguished alumnus and accomplished tax professional, whose career spans top-tier firms including Grant Thornton, Deloitte, Wipro, and the Chartered Institute of Taxation. With years of experience, Mr. Goel shared his journey and offered invaluable insights to students poised at the threshold of their professional futures.

To enhance the participants' understanding, Mr. Goel highlighted several crucial skills and trends that students should focus on. First and foremost, He stressed the importance of Communication and that it is not just about language fluency but about possessing deep knowledge of current affairs, industry developments, and broader societal contexts. He illustrated this with the example of the Union Budget, urging students to stay informed even if, in the present, these topics seem distant. He also reminded them that foundational accounting and financial knowledge is non-negotiable; while tools like Excel or Word may come and go, the core principles of finance and accounting will always anchor a successful career. In addition, he introduced the growing relevance of AI prompt skills urging students to master how to effectively engage with AI tools, as this will be a competitive advantage in future roles.

In response to the common confusion among students about choosing between CA, MBA, direct jobs, or diplomas, Mr. Goel offered a refreshing perspective. He welcomed their uncertainty, viewing it not as a weakness but as a strength, a sign that they are still open to possibilities and exploration. He encouraged them to actively seek exposure, internships, projects, and real-world job experiences so they can see firsthand what different roles entail.

So, by staying curious and embracing diverse experiences, he assured them they would eventually identify a path that truly excites them.

The event concluded with an **interactive Q&A session** where students clarified doubts regarding career options, skill development, and how to apply their learning in real-world contexts.

Conclusion

This session left students inspired and equipped with a broader perspective. They now have a clearer sense of how to balance foundational knowledge, proactive learning, and openness to possibilities as they shape their futures in commerce and beyond. Students engaged thoughtfully, sharing their aspirations, and walked away with a much clearer roadmap for their next steps.
