The Department of Law, Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies (MAIMS), successfully organized a Value-Added Course on "Research Writing, AI Tools and Soft Skill Development" from 5th February to 31st March 2026 in online mode (Google Meet), with sessions conducted twice a week, every Tuesday and Thursday, 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

The course aimed to equip students with essential competencies in academic research writing, ethical use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools, and professional soft skills, which are crucial in today's academic and professional environment. The program covered a comprehensive range of Research Writing topics including fundamentals of research writing, structuring research papers with abstracts, literature review, methodology, and references, along with the application of AI tools for literature review, writing assistance, referencing, and plagiarism detection. It also focused on enhancing soft skills such as communication, presentation, group discussion, and professional profiling, while emphasizing research ethics, academic integrity, and publication processes including journal indexing such as Scopus, Web of Science, etc. The course provided practical exposure to participants, enabling them to develop structured research papers and improve their academic writing and presentation abilities.

The sessions were delivered by esteemed resource persons including Dr. Namarta Sharma, Ms. Smita Gupta, Dr. Arushi Bathla, Dr. Preeti Goel, Ms. Priyanka Aggarwal, and Ms. Vrinda Krishnatray, whose expert guidance enriched the learning experience. Participants were required to maintain a minimum of 80% attendance, complete assignments, actively participate in discussions, and submit a research paper or book chapter as part of the evaluation process.

Upon successful completion, participants were awarded e-certificates, and selected papers are proposed to be published in an ISBN-indexed book. The course witnessed enthusiastic participation from 98 students and concluded successfully, significantly contributing to enhancing students' research capabilities, ethical awareness, and employability skills. The event was conducted under the guidance of Prof. (Dr.) Rajni Malhotra Dhingra, Director, MAIMS, and Prof. (Dr.) Praveen Kumar Gupta, Head, Department of Law, with the continuous support of faculty coordinators and student volunteers ensuring its smooth execution.
