The 4th International Model United Nations & Youth Parliament Competition, organized on October 31 and November 1, 2025 by the Department of Law, Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies (MAIMS), concluded successfully after two days of engaging deliberations and enthusiastic participation. Each committee engaged participants in dynamic debates and meaningful discussions, encouraging policy-oriented thinking, leadership, and diplomacy among youth.

The inaugural ceremony was held on October 31. The Chief guest was honourable Sri Rakesh Asthana, a decorated IPS officer.
