The Internship and Placement Committee of Department of Law, Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies, successfully organized Mock Interviews as part of Lex Week 2026 on

23rd April 2026 in offline mode, with participation from around 140 students of the 2nd, 4th, 6th and 8th semesters. The activity was designed to provide students across all years of the programme with hands-on exposure to the interview process, enabling them to assess their professional readiness and receive structured feedback from experienced legal practitioners and faculty members.

The mock interviews were conducted across four panels, each comprising legal professionals and/or faculty members with expertise in diverse areas of law. Panel 1 consisted of AOR Prabhat Kumar Rai and Asst. Prof. Ms. Disha Moitra; Panel 2 comprised Adv. Shubham Singh and Asst. Prof. Ms. Simran Chhabra; Panel 3 was constituted by Asst. Prof. Ms. Manika Gandhi and Asst. Prof. Ms. Isha Ma'am; and Panel 4 was led by Dr. Aarushi Aggarwal, Professor. The multi-panel format ensured that all 140 participating students received individual attention and personalised feedback.

Each student appeared before their respective panel and was assessed on a range of parameters including subject knowledge, communication skills, clarity of thought, professional presentation, and the ability to articulate their academic and internship experiences. The panellists engaged students in discussions on their CVs, areas of legal interest, and situational questions reflective of real-world legal practice, thereby simulating the experience of an actual law firm or chamber interview.

Following the interviews, students were provided with constructive and detailed feedback by the respective panel members, highlighting their strengths as well as areas requiring improvement. The session proved particularly valuable for senior semester students who are actively preparing to enter the legal profession, while also giving junior semester students an early and realistic understanding of the expectations of legal employers.

Overall, the Mock Interview session under Lex Week 2026 proved to be a highly productive and enriching exercise, equipping students with greater confidence, professional awareness, and

practical readiness for internship and placement opportunities in the legal field.
